




OVERVIEW

This presentation is designed to provide clarity and focus around the steps in the college application process that all juniors interested in applying to college should be taking this <u>spring and into the</u> <u>summer</u>.

- Not designed to be a comprehensive overview application process.
- Encourage your student to manage these tasks independent of you. Sooner than you think they will be managing far more.
- Schedule an appointment to meet with your child's counselor over the summer for individualized discussions.



WITH MORE AND MORE COLLEGES GOING TEST-FLEXIBLE WHY SHOULD MY STUDENT TAKE A COLLEGE ENTRANCE EXAM?



- Keep your options open with regards to applying to test flexible vs. test required schools
- May be used in scholarship reward decisions
- Scores could help eliminate placement tests later
- Give yourself the opportunity to present a strong academic profile/application

WAIVER OF RIGHTS/RELEASE OF RECORDS FORM DUE June 1st

FERPA protects the privacy of student educational records. In order to release *transcripts* or other educational information on behalf of a student, schools must obtain written consent.

By waiving one's rights to review or access letters of recommendation, the end user (ie. colleges & universities, employers, etc.) can confident that the letter writer is free to speak candidly about the applicant.



TEACHER LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION ASK BY JUNE 1

Considerations:

- Students should ask 2 teachers
- Make request IN PERSON
- Don't always go for the obvious (ie. the class you earned an "A" in)
- Consider intended college major (where applicable)
- Be detailed and thoughtful when completing Naviance Info forms





Parents have access to their student's unofficial transcript through their Parent Connect account. 2023-2024 transcripts will update after August 1, 2024.

NAVIANCE INFORMATION FORMS DUE by June 1st

Teacher Forms

Provides context for your student as a learner

Students should provide DETAILED responses to the prompts

Students should ask their teacher if they require anything in addition to this form

Counselor Form

Offers perspective not otherwise evident when looking at a student's transcript

Students should provide DETAILED responses to the prompts

Form must be completed by June 1st to ensure information is included in the counselor letter

*Parent Form

If you have not already registered your Naviance parent account, contact your student's counselor to obtain your registration code

Your insight is **INVALUABLE**

Form must be completed by June 1 st to ensure information is included in the counselor letter

Accessing Your Parent Naviance Acct

- Email your student's counselor and request to be registered
 - This will trigger receipt of an email containing your user id and a temporary password
 - Create your own unique password

NCAA Athletics

Students Planning to Play Sports in College Should:

-Register with <u>NCAA Eligibility Center</u> by end of junior year (or sooner)

-Review NCAA <u>course requirements</u> and make any necessary adjustments to their senior year schedule (seldom an issue)

TIMELINE REVIEW

All students are encouraged to sit for an SAT/ACT exam during the spring of their junior year, using fall to test again if desired.	Students should obtain a verbal agreement from 2 teachers to write a letter of recommendation on their behalf in the spring of their junior year.	Teacher, Counselor, and Parent Information forms in Naviance MUST be completed by June 1 st .	Every student should complete and submit a Waiver of Rights/Records Release Form to Ms. Hooks by June 1 st .	Use spring/summer to visit college campuses, begin to brainstorm essay ideas, update resume/activities list, and register w/NCAA if applicable.
