Academic Dishonesty/Plagiarism



- ▶ **Policy 8120:** Academic dishonesty through cheating, copying, plagiarizing or altering records, or assisting another in such actions, computer/electronic communication Misuse, falsification , facilitation. Plagiarizing, such as taking someone else's work or ideas; forgery, such as faking a signature of a teacher or parent; or cheating.

Glennlg Honor Code?



Consequences for violations:

1. 1st Offense: May earn a reduced grade on the assignment, on a sliding scale down 0%. This reduced grade is at the discretion of the teacher. Teacher will fill out a Minor Incident Report. Teacher will notify your parent. Teacher can assign further in-class disciplinary consequence(s). (e.g. – classroom detention)
2. 2nd (and subsequent) Offenses: 0% on assignment; teacher will contact parent, disciplinary referral to administrator for discipline under the HCPSS student code of conduct. Parent conference with administrator

- ▶ Students will wear attire that contributes to a safe school environment conducive to learning.

Dress Code

- ▶ Students will not wear attire that is disruptive to the school environment, that promotes illegal or harmful activities, or that could endanger the health or safety of that student or others during school hours and school-related activities.

Safety and Security



- ▶ Our Superintendent, Dr. Martriano has tasked us to create a “Culture of Caring” in our school communities.
- ▶ We are concerned about school safety because we care about making school a safe place to learn and work -- we want you to feel and be safe!
- ▶ To create a school environment that is safe a number of new initiatives will be implemented this year

Safety and Security



- ▶ School Building Opening time 7:00AM. At 7:25AM the school doors are locked. Late students must use the front doors and be buzzed into school.
- ▶ For everyone's safety we are asking students not to open doors for other students or strangers. Please direct all individuals to the main entrance where they will be identified and admitted!
- ▶ School Buzzer & Security System – requires visitors to identify themselves and state their business prior to being admitted and signing into the school.

Safety and Security



- ▶ To insure to safety of students they are no longer permitted in outside in front of the building during lunch.
- ▶ **ALL DRILLS OR EXERCISES ARE ANNOUNCED!**
We are required to have 14 drills: 5 fire drills, 2 Reverse evacuation drills; 2 active assailant drills, 2 severe weather drills. 1 shelter in place. 1 lockdown and 1 duck cover and hold drill.
- ▶ Students will be instructed on the procedures prior to each drill
