

#### **Dates & Deadlines**

- Many schools have early action and priority deadlines as early as Oct. 15, Nov. 1 or Dec. 1
  - University of MD College Park
    - ► November 1<sup>st</sup> Priority Consideration Deadline
- Howard Community College (Application fees waived until January 15, 2018)
  - Freshman Focus March 15, 2019
  - Rouse , Schoenbrodt and STEM Scholars November 15, 2018 Priority Deadline
  - Silas Craft March 15, 2019
- December 1<sup>st</sup> priority scholarship deadline at MANY universities



  - MUST be sent electronically by student.
- Transcript GHS Student Services
- Letters of Recommendation
  - Counselor & Teacher(s)
- Essay
- Interview (optional for some colleges)

- Submit to Mrs. Thorne in Student Services
- Parent Signature Required
- Associated Costs...
  - First three transcripts free
  - \$2 per transcript after (cash or check made out to GHS)
- Allow 20 <u>school</u> days for requests
  - A deadline cheat sheet provided in senior folders

#### **Electronic Submission: What Gets Sent?**


ALL TRANSCRIPTS, LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATIONS FROM COUNSELORS AND TEACHERS WILL BE SENT THROUGH NAVIANCE

- A certified copy of your high school transcript which includes your current schedule
- Glenelg High School Profile
- Letter of recommendation from counselor (if requested)

#### **Teacher Recommendations**

- 1. Personally ask teachers
- 2. Complete teacher information form or provide information teacher requests
- 3. Submit yellow teacher request form (hard copy) to teacher
- 4. Request teacher on Naviance <u>after</u> transcripts requests are submitted
- 5. Write a thank you note!

Complete & return to each of your teachers 20 days in advance



Note for teachers: If a student requests additional recommendations from colleges not on this Est, they must provide you with enother Teacher Recommendation Request
